18:30-19:00

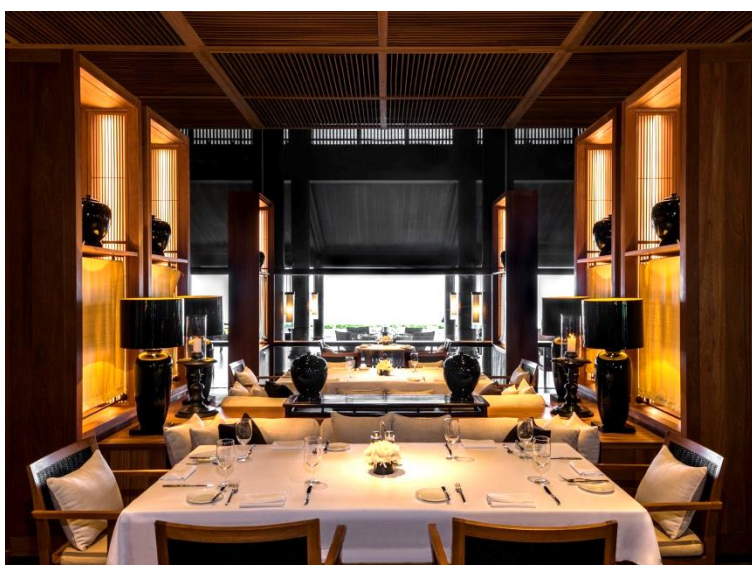
Join us for a festive-themed recital in the intimate setting of the Central Pavilion. The show will be performed by talented local children.

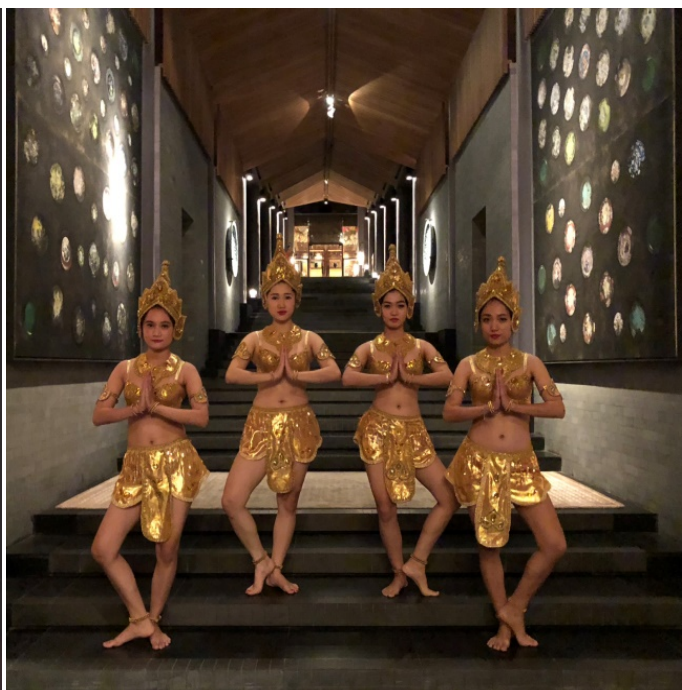
